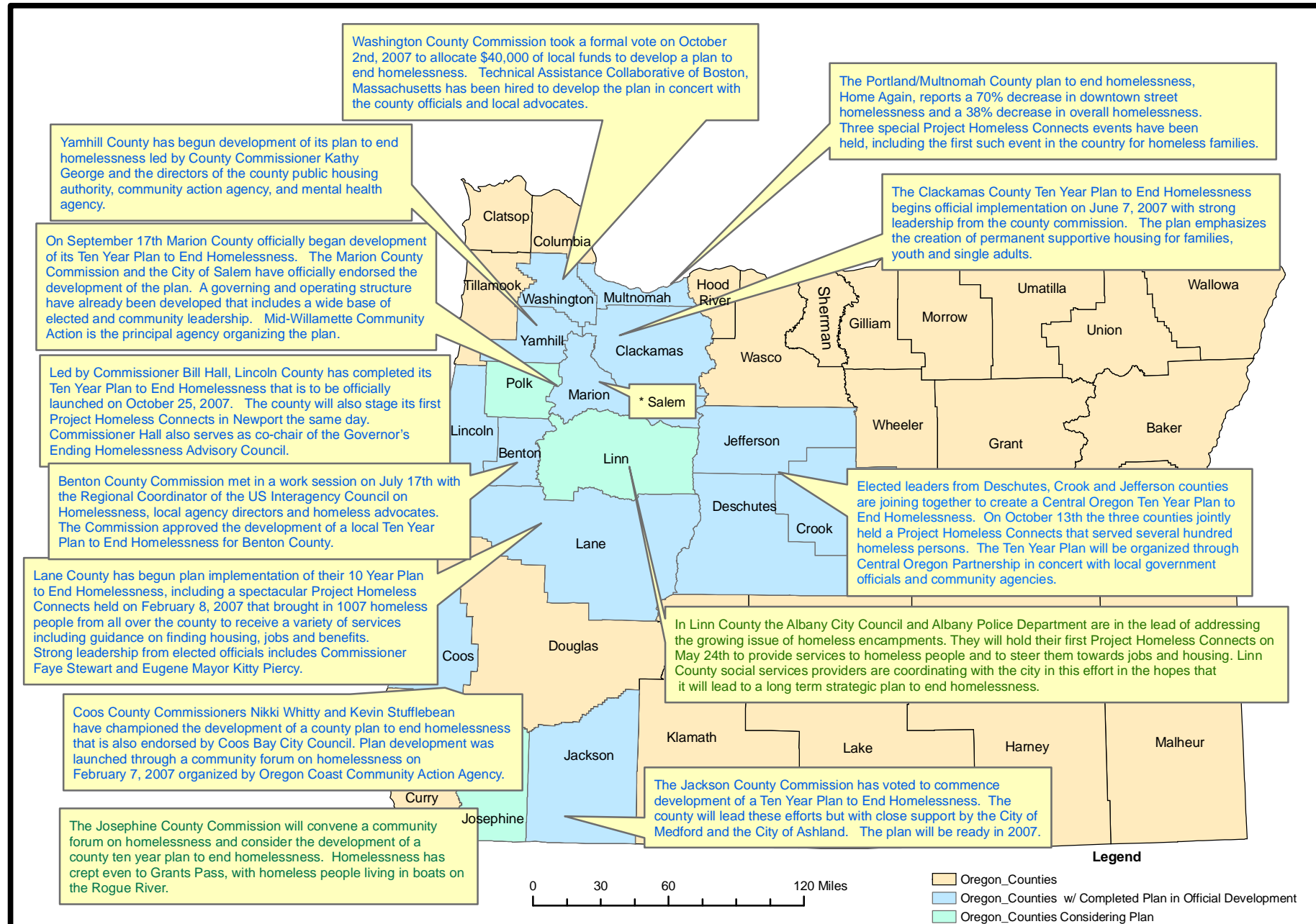


# October 2007 Status Report on 10 Year Plans to End Homelessness in Oregon



Governor Kulongoski has allocated \$27 million for housing for very low income persons in his 2008 budget, including \$16 million targeted to housing for homeless persons. The Governor's Ending Homelessness Advisory Council, representing state agencies and stakeholder groups, is developing the State of Oregon Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness. The United States Interagency Council on Homelessness is working with the Governor, state agencies and county commissions to coordinate state-wide efforts in ending homelessness.
